Contemporary Grey Limestone

Contemporary Grey Limestone is a natural stone excavated from the earth. Unlike concrete which is man-made, natural stone had been under intensive pressure and heat underground. Giving our paving slabs a unique look. Therefore to preserve this unique look and durability we recommend all customers read the following

Natural Stone characteristics are variation in colour, texture, blemishes, veining, holes and chippings to the corners and sides of the stone. Sample pieces provided by Barrow and Stone are small and will vary, they will not hold a true representation of the paving therefore we strongly suggest you talk to one of our trained staff about seeing larger pieces.

Contemporary Grey Limestone is extremely sensitive to chemicals that are acid based, please seek professional advice when wanting to apply any product to your Contemporary Grey Limestone. Do not spill any cement or mortar onto the Contemporary Grey Limestone, if so please clean off immediately with a wet cloth or sponge.

Before cleaning your Contemporary Grey Limestone please ask one of our trained friendly staff for professional guidance and that the conditions and environment are right for the desired area to have your Contemporary Grey Limestone.

Contemporary Grey Limestone cannot be butt jointed we recommend that you use a 8-10mm gap.

Dimensional tolerance of Contemporary Grey Limestone +/- 4mm

Barrow and Stone will not refund or exchange the Contemporary Grey Limestone because of any variation in the stone or natural stone characteristics. Therefore we highly recommend that you order an extra 10% when ordering Contemporary Grey Limestone to account for wastage and any pieces that you may not like.
